Studio art learning outcomes

Specific Requirements for Admission to the Bachelor of fine Arts (BFA)

 Successful completion of at least one ART course and acceptable major acceptance portfolio review in the Freshman or Sophomore year. Students pursuing the BFA Major in Studio Art must also successfully complete a Junior Portfolio Review in the semester prior to enrolling in ART 498 Senior Thesis I and maintain a minimum GPA of 3.0 in major requirements.
